Creating Pretty Cards - Sketch Challenge #25

This basic fold card uses Lacy & Lovely and Everything Eleanor stamp sets. The folded card is 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" and fits in a 4-3/8" x 5-3/4" envelope.



Instructions

Step 1

Use the Stampin' Trimmer to cut the following:

- (1) 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece of Tangerine Tango card stock
- (1) 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Tangerine Tango and Very Vanilla Venetian Romance Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- (1) 1-1/2" x 4" piece of Soft Suede Venetian Romance DSP

Step 2

Use the Simply Scored Scoring Tool and Stylus to score the Tangerine Tango card stock at 4-1/4". Use the Bone Folder to fold on the score line and create a nice crease.

Step 3

Use the Multipurpose Liquid Glue to attach the 1-1/2" x 4" piece of Soft Suede Venetian Romance DSP 1" from the top of the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Tangerine Tango and Very Vanilla Venetian Romance DSP. Stamp the bird from Everything Eleanor in Soft Suede classic ink on the DSP in the lower right hand corner.

Step 4

Cut 6-1/2" length of Daffodil Delight 1/2" Seam Binding ribbon. Apply it to the DSP vertically 1/2" from the left edge and attach it on the back using tape. Cut another 3-1/2" of the Seam Binding and tie a knot to the Seam Binding on the front of the card where it meets the Soft Suede DSP. Trim the ends diagonally.

Hint: Attaching the ribbon with tape is very secure and it saves ribbon.

Step 5

Use the Multipurpose Liquid Glue to secure the DSP with the Seam Binding to the Tangerine Tango card.

Step 6

On a scrap of Very Vanilla card stock, stamp the *swirl* from Everything Eleanor in Daffodil Delight classic ink and then stamp *Miss You* from Lacy & Lovely in Soft Suede classic ink on top of it. Use Decorative Label punch to punch out the image you stamped and another in Daffodil Delight.

Step 7

Stack the two punched Decorative Labels with the Daffodil Delight in the back. Use the Paper-Piercing tool to create a hole and insert the Champagne Glimmer brad. Slide the labels apart slightly and glue together. Apply two Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the labels. Place them on the 1-1/2" x 4" piece of Soft Suede Venetian Romance DSP on the card.
